About Us

The Scottish Centre for Children with Motor Impairments at the Craighalbert Centre, is a Grant Aided Special School and the national centre for children with motor impairments. The Centre's programme combines the principles of conductive education with the Scottish curriculum to teach the children independence and everyday life skills.

Facilities

Located in the Craigmarloch area of Cumbernauld, the Craighalbert Centre has excellent conference and catering facilities available for hire for your organisation's meeting needs, from conferences to study days, meetings to seminars.

The Centre's conference room can be configured to accommodate up to 50 delegates theatre-style, or smaller numbers for boardroom or bespoke set-up. The conference room offers access to PCs and laptops, with WiFi access throughout. Hire of projectors, whiteboards, wide screen TV, DVD/video players and flip charts is also available.

The Centre also has a smaller meeting room that can accommodate up to 30 people theatre-style, and smaller numbers in boardroom or informal layouts.



Catering

The Centre's Catering Manager has a wide range of menus available to suit all conference and meeting needs. Special dietary requirements can also be accommodated.

Catering includes:

- Tea, coffee, pastries, muffins, biscuits, scones or hot rolls on arrival
- Mid-morning tea, coffee, pastries, muffins, biscuits, scones or hot rolls
- Lunch buffets, baked potatoes, soups or two-course hot lunches
- Afternoon tea, coffee, pastries, muffins, biscuits or scones

Travel

The Centre has ample parking, and for those travelling by train, Croy station is approximately one mile away. If required, a shuttle bus can be arranged between the Centre and the station (please note that a charge will apply for this).
