- In March, the squadron drew their star prize raffle (first prize was a Rangers UEFA Cup Final shirt signed by Barry Ferguson) and raised £518.
- In early April, Billy Forrester and Andy Everett completed a sponsored 24-hour Treadmill Trek in aid of Craighalbert. Taking turns to march for one hour periods whilst carrying a 20kg pack (achieving an impressive 36 miles each), the pair have raised £900 and counting!

124 Field Squadron (Royal Engineers) at Cumbernauld TA Centre have donated £1458.80 so far this year.


Clarkston Chiropractic and Distinction Health & Beauty held an open day in March, raising £186.96.
